



## PRIVACY POLICY

Digital Cuisine SRL is registered with the Trade Register under no. J38 / 570 / 2019 and operates in accordance with the laws of Romania, unique registration code 40985121 based in Ion Referendaru Nr.4, bl. A18, sc.C, ap.1, Râmnicu Vâlcea, respects the confidentiality of the personal data provided by the data subjects and undertakes to protect it by respecting this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes the personal information we collect from you or that you provide through [www.digitalcuisine.ro](http://www.digitalcuisine.ro) (our "SITE") and how this information may be used or disclosed by us.

Our privacy policy does not apply to information collected from any third party site that may have a link to or is accessible from our SITE.

Please read the following carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat it.

### The information we collect about you

We collect several types of information from and about our SITE users, including, for example:

- information that we collect when browsing our SITE, including IP addresses, cookies and web beacons;
- first and last name, contact details, records and copies of correspondence (including e-mail addresses), if you contact us and access the services of Digital Cuisine SRL online

### Usage details, IP addresses, cookies and other technologies

- **Usage details and IP addresses.** We may collect statistical information regarding the equipment, actions and navigation patterns of our SITE users. This information is derived from your visit and navigation on the Site. The information may include, for example:
  - o traffic, journal data and other communication data;
  - o information about the resources you access;
  - o information about your computer and your internet connection (for example, including your IP address, operating system and browser type), for system administration.
- **Cookies.** We may obtain information about the general use of the Internet by you using cookies. A cookie is a small file stored on your computer's hard drive. The use of cookies helps us to improve our SITE and offer a better and more personalized service, which allows us to:
  - we estimate the size of the public and the usage patterns;
  - we store information regarding your preferences, which allows us to customize the SITE according to your individual interests;

- to recognize you when you return to our SITE.

You can refuse to accept cookies by enabling the appropriate setting on your browser. If you select this setting, you may not have access to certain parts of our SITE. If you have not adjusted your browser setting to refuse cookies, your system will continue to accept cookies when you direct your browser to our SITE. Please further document the aspects specified in the Cookies Policy.

- **Web beacons.** Some pages of the SITE may contain electronic images known as web beacons (also referred to as single pixel gifs). Web beacons allow the company to collect certain information about SITE users, including, for example, the number of users accessing each web page, traffic data, journal data and other communication data, access information resources and information regarding the user's computer and internet connection (including IP addresses, operating systems and browser type). Web beacons are not used to access your personal information on the Site, but are used only to compile aggregate statistics on the use of the SITE and to verify the integrity of the system and server.

## Use of information

We use the information we collect about you or that you provide to us, including personal data, for the following purposes:

- to present our SITE and its content in a manner that is appropriate and efficient for you and your computer;
- to provide you with the information you request from us;
- to inform you about our new services and products, or changes made to them, including direct marketing;
- compiling user statistics;
- security and improvement of our SITE.

## Disclosure of your information

We may disclose the personal information we obtain through this Site to third parties in order to comply with a court decision or other legal obligation; execute a contract, request or apply our conditions of use and other agreements; to protect the rights and assets of the company and its affiliates. This includes exchanging information to protect against fraud and reduce the risk of fraud.

The rights you enjoy in connection with the processing of your personal data provided by law are the following:

- the possibility to obtain from the company, upon request and free of charge, the confirmation that your personal data are processed by us, as well as details regarding this processing. The application can be submitted free of charge only once a year;
- the right to rectify, update, block or transform into anonymous data the data whose processing is not in accordance with the law, especially incomplete or inaccurate data;
- the right to oppose at any time, for well-founded and legitimate reasons related to your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data;
- the right to object free of charge and without justification to the processing of your personal data for direct marketing, on behalf of the data operator or on behalf of a third party or to disclose your data for this purpose;
- the right to challenge decisions made exclusively on the basis of data processing performed by automated means and which have legal consequences for you.

- the right to file a complaint with ANSPDCP, in the situation in which you appreciate that the company has affected the rights provided by law.
- the right to bring you to justice, in case you feel that the company violated your rights provided by law.

## Storage time

We will keep your personal data for a period of time necessary for the purposes indicated in the "Use of information" section, but not more than 2 years. After the data will no longer be needed for these purposes, it will be:

- damaged
- transferred to another operator of personal data, provided that the personal data are processed within limits and purposes similar to those initially agreed
- transformed into anonymous data and kept exclusively for statistical, historical or scientific research purposes.
